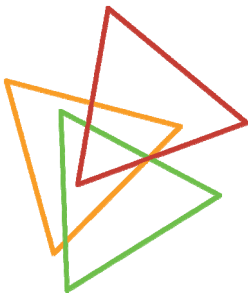
You will be receiving another email from me using **Adobe Sign** that will allow you to **sign the necessary documentation online**.
